



TennCare and Cover Kids



Eligibility guidelines

Individuals who are eligible for TennCare or Cover Kids will not be eligible in the Marketplace. These individuals already have Quality Health Plans for free or low cost. The income below is **monthly** income.

If Adults and Children are **ABOVE** the monthly income guidelines: **They are eligible to enroll in the Marketplace.** They can enroll at [Healthcare.gov](https://www.healthcare.gov), through a CAC locally, or by calling 1-800-318-2596. If they need assistance understanding insurance and need to attend an orientation, please have them call **Get Covered Nashville: 615-724-1339**. They will be directed to an event in which they can get personal help and have their questions answered.

If Adults and/or children in the household are **below** the listed income amount, (Adults between 21 and 65 must also meet category requirements – have dependent children in the household, be pregnant, or deemed disabled by the federal government) they need to apply for TennCare.

Apply for TennCare/Medicaid: Formerly, one applied at each county Department of Human Services, now everyone applies through [healthcare.gov](https://www.healthcare.gov) and they will be screened for TennCare.

Apply for Cover Kids: If children are over 100%, but below the 250% income shown above, they can apply for Cover Kids with their TennCare denial letter they receive from DHS. They can call Cover Kids at: **1-866-620-8864** for an application.

Health Assist: If Adults are under 100%, but do not meet category requirements for TennCare, they can call this number for help in finding a medical home and help with medications. 615-313-9972 or toll free: 1-800-269-4038 (state-wide).
